Camp will run for seven weeks (Mon-Fri) from June 28^{th} to August 13^{th} with the exception of Monday, July 5^{th} . We operate our camp daily from 8:30am - 4:00pm with the option of early drop off or late pick up for an additional fee.

Since we are still operating in a COVID environment and want to keep safety a high priority, we are not planning any bus trips this summer. 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2021 Camp Rules

- 1. I will have FUN! In order to have fun. I will follow the rules!
- 2. When I hear the whistle blow. I will stop what I am doing and look to my counselors.
- 3. I will keep my hands to myself. No hitting, pushing or shoving.
- 4. I will only use kind words when speaking to my fellow campers or counselors. NO bad words!
- 5. I will always stay where the rest of the camp is unless I am with a counselor. If I need to use the bathroom or get a drink, I will ask permission from one of the counselors.

CAMP CHADWICK 2021 COVID-19 PREVENTION PROTOCOLS

- Regular Camp Drop-off 8:30am-9:00am. Regular Camp Pick-Up 3:30pm-4:00pm.
- Paid Extended Camp Drop-off 8:00am-8:30am. Paid Extended Camp Pick-Up 4:00pm-5:00pm.
- Recommended social distancing guidelines will be implemented.
- Masks will be worn by all staff when social distancing is not possible.
- Masks will be worn by campers, with the exception of eating, drinking, and social distancing mask breaks.
- Campers must bring their own mask.
- Daily health screenings will be given to campers and staff before entering the pavilion.
- Parents/guardians must remain in their vehicles and will not be permitted past the designated drop-off point.
- Parents/guardians will wait in their vehicles at a designated pick-up location while campers are escorted to them at the end of the camp day.
- Parents/Guardians who need to pick a child up early must follow our normal Pick-up procedure, but call upon arrival and wait in their vehicle at a designated pick-up location until the camper is escorted to them.
- Temperatures will be taken at check in/Randomly throughout the day
- Camp groups will have a 1-10 ratio.
- Hand washing will be enforced after each activity.
- Hand sanitizer is readily available throughout the pavilion.
- There will be no large group gatherings.
- Any campers who tests positive for COVID-19 while enrolled in Camp Chadwick or within 14 days of being at Camp Chadwick must be reported to the Director immediately.
- In the instance a camper is diagnosed with COVID-19, while enrolled in Camp Chadwick or within 14 days of being at Camp Chadwick, we will close for additional cleaning and sanitizing. The campers who were in immediate contact with the infected camper must self-quarantine for 10 days from the date of last exposure. A credit will be issued to those families affected.
