



## TO FURTHER ENHANCE YOUR VISIT TO THE PARK, PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING:

- -No hunting, swimming or wading allowed
- -Dogs must be leashed and stay on the trail only.
  - -Clean up after your dogs.
  - -No dogs allowed in playground or pavilion areas.
- -Bicycles are allowed on the trail only.
  -Roller blading is allowed only in
  Hockey Rink.
- -Fishing and boating limited to hours posted.
- -Return all life jackets directly to guard at ranger station.
  - -Dock boats after use and return oars to shelter house.
  - -No unnecessary noise, littering, use of alcoholic beverages or non prescription drugs or other misbehavior.
    - -No driving on the grass.
      -No feeding the geese.
- -A New York State Fishing License is required (for ages 16 and up) to fish at Chadwick Lake.
- -Outddoor Exercise equipment is for adults only. Ages 14 and up permitted.

Observe Chadwick Lake catch limits: 2 Bass 14" or more, 10 Pan fish, 5 Trout

-lce Skating only permitted when suitable conditions are determined by the Commissioner.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN REVOCATION OF PERMIT.

## **ANNUAL PERMITS**

A permit is required for entrance into Chadwick Lake Park. The following types of permits are available. Individuals over 18 are required to purchase their own permit. The fees below include 2 permit stickers per household with valid license plate numbers.

#### RESIDENT:

Effective 1 year from date of issue. Fee: \$20

#### NON-RESIDENTS:

Effective 1 year from date of issue. Fee: \$40

### SENIOR CITIZEN:

A lifetime Permit Card is issued to those sixty (60) years and over. Resident Senior Fee: FREE Non-Resident Senior Fee: \$40 Covers your spouse & minors

## DAY PASS:

PARK ENTRANCE ONLY 4 people including driver Resident Fee: \$10 Non-Resident Fee: \$20 Note: Over 4 people \$2 each

# QUALIFIED DISABLED VETERANS:

(30% Disabled, must show documentation)

Fee: FREE

PARK PERMIT STICKER MUST BE ADHERED TO THE CAR WINDSHIELD OR DRIVERS SIDE WINDOW. NO EXCEPTIONS.

#### **BOAT RENTALS**

Available on a daily basis to annual permit holders for the entire day. No private water vessels are permitted including but not limited to kayaks, canoes, jet skis etc. Adult must accompany a child in a boat at all times.

Resident Fee: \$15

Resident Senior Citizens: \$10

Non-Residents: \$25 Non-Resident Senior: \$20

## BOAT GUEST PERMITS

Fishing/boating ages 16+ Per person Fee: \$5

Guest permits issued only when accompanied by an Annual permit holder.

Maximum 4 per day

### BOAT RENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

-Renter must be an annual permit holder or lifetime Senior Permit Holder.

-Renter must be at least 18 years old.
-NY State fishing license is required for 16 and older.

-All boaters must wear lifejackets in the boat. DEC regulates that everyone must wear a life jacket November through April.

-NO pets in boat.

-Row Boat Size - 3 Seats.

-Max cap. 3 Adults to a boat or 2 Adults & 2 small children.

-All renters must take oars.

-Only electric motors are permitted.
-No personal boating vessels are allowed on Chadwick Lake.

-All garbage and fishing equipment/ materials must be removed from the boat. -Please return boat to the upright position after use.

-Oars must be returned to the oar shed.
-Lifejackets must be returned to the
Ranger station.

-Notify Ranger station of any boat issues.
