I believe we hit everything we needed 17 to during the last meeting. 18 This is the -- just to refresh 19 everyone's memory, this is in the corner of the 20 parking lot, very close to McDonald's, over by 21 Big Lots and Auto Zone or --22 MR. BELL: Yeah. 23 CHAIRMAN SCALZO: They're going to be 24 removing part of the asphalt, the corner of the asphalt parking lot, to put this coffee -- Ready 25
