**STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**WHEREAS** on March 17, 2020, I declared and proclaimed a disaster emergency in the Town of Newburgh effective as of 12:40 pm and ordered the temporary suspension of certain policies, rules and local laws; and.

**WHEREAS**, said State of Emergency was extended on May 14, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, said State of Emergency was extended again on June 14 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, as government and private business's reopen for business and Covid 19 infection rates in New York State are reduced, a certain measure within the State of Emergency with respect to non essential employee work schedules appears no longer warranted or necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I**, Gilbert J. Piaquadio, Supervisor of the Town of Newburgh, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State of New York, do hereby amend the declaration and proclamation of the disaster state of emergency for non-essential employees of the Town of Newburgh, as extended and heretofore amended by Amendment No. 1 to delete the directive to all Town Department Heads to arrange, modify or limit the work schedules for non-essential employees of their respective departments.

This Amendment No. 2 shall take effect immediately.
