At the Town of Newburgh Workshop Meeting conducted on December 27, 2021, a Town of Newburgh Certificate of Achievement was presented to George Eliadis. Mr. Eliadis also received the highest possible ACT score of 36 which earned him a Nation Merit Scholarship.
