Comments:

The Planning Department has reviewed the submitted materials regarding the appeal for a use variance and has found no evidence that intermunicipal or countywide impacts would result from its approval. County Planning recommends that the Board act on this variance request only if the applicant satisfies the unnecessary hardship standard, as defined by New York State law.

The courts of New York hold that the unnecessary hardship standard is satisfied by competent proof of each of the following:

1. the land in question cannot yield a reasonable return, in dollars and cents, if used for any use permitted in the zone,
2. the use to be authorized by the variance will not alter the essential character of the locality,
3. the hardship is unique to the parcel and not general throughout the zoning district, and
4. the hardship is not self-created.

We look forward to reviewing this project when submitted by the Planning Board. Should the ZBA wish to address the underlying issue, they could recommend as part of any action on this matter that the Town Board review §185-83 of the Town Code and determine whether other zones in the Town may be appropriate for solar installations.
