DESCRIPTION:

The submitted plan is a proposal for a lot line change between the two parcels listed above. The project is located along Fostertown Road, a county road, in the Town of Newburgh. The land is a gentle sloping parcel. We are proposing to add approx. 60' of property to s-b-1: 39-1-23 from the adjoining parcel s-b-1: 39-1-24 as shown on the attached plans. The existing lots are serviced by individual septic systems. One of the lots is attached to the town water and the other is utilizing a private well.

The proposed change to the property line will have no affect on the existing septic systems and no new structures are proposed. This is a simple lot line change to give the smaller lot a larger backyard area.

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
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
