22	work in two ways. Either you have an audit or
23	you have a controller. So we pass a budget at
24	the beginning of the year, and if we had a
25	controller we would tell that controller hey,

just don't go over budget, just keep spending the 2 money. If you get in trouble, let us know. We 3 don't operate that way. We have an audit. At 4 every audit meeting -- every meeting we have an 5 audit. What that means is -- if you noticed, б Mrs. Greene abstained from the audit tonight. 7 That means she did not review it. There's a 8 stack. Like tonight it was \$600,000 worth of 9 10 bills. Every Councilperson reviews those to make sure they look legitimate to them. That's what 11 an audit is. It's an audit of the bills to be 12 paid. Then we will also have an auditor come in 13 that we pay to audit, an independent auditor. 14 Whenever we want, the State will come in and 15 audit those audits as well. We're pretty well 16 audited. 17

18 MS. MANDEL: You're very well audited. 19 That's why I asked. You guys are always 20 auditing. It's like what's going on.

21SUPERVISOR PIAQUADIO: Oh, I see. I22got you. What else? Anything?

23 MS. MANDEL: Yeah. And then I was just 24 wondering regarding the donations for Chadwick, 25 where do those donations come from? Is that from

TOWN BOARD MEETING - 3/8/21 1 26 the Town of Newburgh Day and stuff, or like 2 concerts? 3 SUPERVISOR PIAQUADIO: Our main 4 donations are from Community Day. We send out 5 letters. 90 percent of them are businesses that б actually just donate, and that allows us to do 7 the fireworks and everything else we have going 8 at Community Day. We have money left over. 9 Usually we raise \$25,000. The fireworks cost us 10 10. So we have money left over to do other 11 things. That's what we're paying for like 12 Musicians In The Park and what not. That's where 13 that money comes from. 14 15 MS. MANDEL: Awesome. Okay. I was just wondering. 16 17 And then all the other expenses that you guys were talking about in terms of the 18 expenses for the improvement to the water system, 19 that's all in relation to that \$1,800,000 that 20 we're getting from New York City; right? That's 21 what I was understanding. I reviewed the 22 material --23 24 SUPERVISOR PIAQUADIO: Correct. What happened there was New York City -- we use the 25

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aqueduct, New York City's aqueduct, but it will 2 be shut down. They want to make sure we'll be 3 self-sufficient with our reservoir, sharing with 4 New Windsor. So they gave us money to make 5 improvements to make sure when they do shut down, б we'll have enough water supply. 7 MS. MANDEL: Got you. That's what I 8 thought. 9 10 Okay. And then I just have one last question, and that was -- that's really regarding 11 Chadwick Lake. Jim, I'm sorry to ask you, I know 12 you're not on the Board. I just wanted to ask 13 this question. I know Lap For Life isn't going 14 to happen this year because of the pandemic. 15 Natalene is not going to do the race. We've been 16 17 talking about moving our Keep It Moving race to June. Do you guys think you would be open for a 18 I know we're still in the red zone. race? Now 19 they have a lot of recommendations for having 20 outdoor races in a safe environment. 21 T was wondering, is that something that Chadwick is 22 open to at this time or not yet? 23 SUPERVISOR PIAOUADIO: Is Jim Presutti 24 out there? 25

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alarm that didn't report. That alarm line was 2 That was fixed. Chlorine was put back in out. 3 the water. They flushed the hydrants. They did 4 about thirty tests, sent them over to Orange 5 County and they said good to go. So we're back б good. 7 MR. FETTER: So it's a piece of 8 historical equipment. I know you're upgrading 9 10 the system now, aren't you, or is that done? SUPERVISOR PIAQUADIO: Actually to the 11 chlorinator, that's been done awhile back. I 12 don't think we're upgrading that again. I think 13 we're in good shape there. It's only a small 14 pump. It's unfortunate it failed. Little things 15 mean a lot sometimes. 16 That's true. 17 MR.
